## DETAILS

**Father/Daughter Ball**

- This event will be the 12th Annual Father-Daughter Dance/Sweetheart Ball for all of the Girl Scouts at Del Rey. The theme is "*Night in the City*", and promises to be a fun party atmosphere.
- A permission slip and fee is \$15.00 is required per girl (form is attached). Please make a check payable to **Troop 30122** and leave it in the Girl Scout K/1 box (inside the Del Rey front office) no later than Monday - March 18.
- The \$15 fee will include a custom made patch for our Daisy Scout tunic, and a printed digital photo of each girl and her father/special guy in a keepsake frame. This is an exclusive event for Dads and Daughters – only moms who are working at the ball may attend (see below for how to help).

**Dessert for Dads**

- For this pre-event dessert will be provided for each Daisy Scout and her father, and it will be served by our mother volunteers. This event was designed with Father's Day in mind, so it couples nicely with the Father/Daughter Ball (though it is open and intended for all of our Troop Dads, regardless of participation in the Ball).
- Each Daisy will have a special something to give to her father (something she will have made during a special troop session TBD late March/early April).
- Each Daisy will receive an event participation patch as well.

**Moms – How do I help?** *Glad you asked! We need your help to make the night successful!*

- Dessert for Dads (2 Moms) – We need 2 moms to help set up and serve at our Dessert for Dad event. The shift is 445 – 645pm.
- F/D Ball Set-up (2 Moms) – Each troop must furnish 2 people to help set-up the decorations before the Ball. The shift is 400 – 530pm.
- F/D Ball Chaperone (2 Moms) – Each troop must provide 2 chaperones to work during the dance. The shift is 645 – 845pm.
- F/D Ball Food Donation (3 each) – Our troop is responsible for donating 3 fruit trays. Delivery of fruit tray(s) is to the Del Rey MPR @ 530pm.
